PUBLIC CONSULTATION ON THE FIREARMS (AMENDMENT) BILL 2023

BACKGROUND

- 1. The Firearms (Amendment) Bill 2023 ("the Bill") would amend the Firearms Act, Chapter 386 of the Law of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines 2009 Edition, by
 - (a) creating three (3) new offences, namely -
 - (i) the contravention of terms or conditions of licence or permit;
 - (ii) possession of ghost gun or a firearm produced by a 3D printing process
 - (iii) trafficking in firearms or prohibited weapons; and
 - (b) increasing the penalties for certain offences in the Act.
- 2. The Bill was introduced in the House of Assembly by the Prime Minister, Dr. the Honourable Ralph E. Gonsalves, on Thursday 23rd November 2023 and was placed before a Select Committee of the House.
- 3. Comments on the Bill may be submitted to the Clerk of the House of Assembly.
- 4. The Bill has eleven (11) clauses.

KEY PROVISIONS OF THE BILL

- 5. **Clause 2** of the Billwould insert a new section 11A in the Act. By the new section 11A, the holder of a licence or permit who contravenes a term or condition of the licence or permit would commit an offence. The person would be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding two thousand dollars or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months.
- 6. **Clause3** would increase the penalties for the offence of possession of firearm or ammunition in contravention of section 14.

- 9. **Clause 6**would insert in the Act sections 19A (Possession of ghost gun or 3D printed firearm) and 19B (trafficking in firearms). A person in possession of two or more firearms or prohibited weapons would commit the offence of trafficking. A burden would be placed on the accused to prove the contrary.
- 10. **Clause 7** would amend section 20 (Restriction on sale of firearms).
