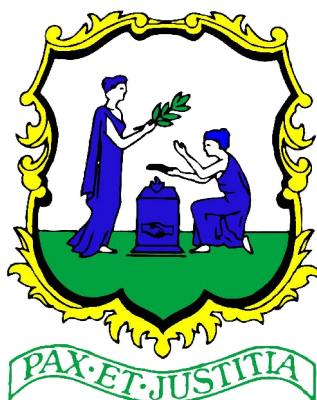

Management's Responsibility for the Summary Financial Statements

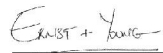
Management is responsible for the preparation of a summary of the audited financial statements on the basis of their established criteria as described in Note 1.

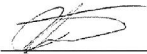
