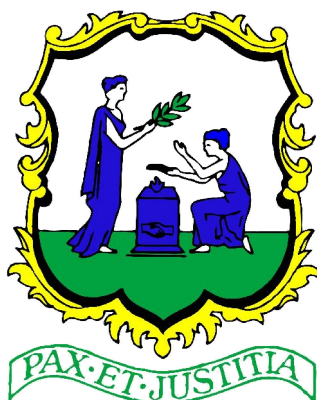

AGREEMENT ON MARITIME DELIMITATION BETWEEN BARBADOS AND SAINT VINCENT AND THE GRENADINES

1. In exercise of the provisions of section 17 of the Maritime Areas Act, Cap 464 of the Revised Edition of the Laws of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, 2009, concerning "Overlapping jurisdiction", an **Agreement between the Government of Barbados and the Government of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines on the Delimitation of the Maritime Boundary between Barbados and Saint Vincent and the Grenadines**, was concluded on 31st August, 2015.

SCHEDULE

AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF BARBADOS AND THE GOVERNMENT OF SAINT VINCENT AND THE GRENADINES ON THE DELIMITATION OF THE MARITIME BOUNDARY BETWEEN BARBADOS AND SAINT VINCENT AND THE GRENADINES

The Government of Barbados and the Government of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, hereinafter referred to as “the Parties”,

Moved by the desire to deepen their relationship through mutual cooperation;

Bearing in mind the importance of the sustainable development of their marine resources;

Acknowledging that the sustainable development of adjoining marine resources can be promoted through collaboration;

Conscious of the historic and contemporary importance of the marine environment to their peoples;

Sharing a commitment to regional integration as embodied in the Revised Treaty of Chaguaramas Establishing the Caribbean Community including the Single Market and Economy;

Mindful of the spirit and principles in the Revised Treaty of Basseterre Establishing the Organisation of Eastern Caribbean States Economic Union;

Mindful also of the Caribbean Community Common Fisheries Policy;

Noting the importance of the delimitation of maritime boundaries by agreement in accordance with international law in providing clarity and certainty for the exercise of jurisdiction over their respective maritime zones;

Underlining the importance of the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea to which both States are party,

AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

1. This Agreement establishes a single maritime boundary for delimitation of the maritime space between Barbados and Saint Vincent and the Grenadines.
2. The line of delimitation is based on equidistance which is considered an equitable solution in this case. This line is calculated from the baselines, as defined by their respective national laws, from which the territorial seas of Barbados and Saint Vincent and the Grenadines are measured.

Article 2

1. The line of delimitation of the maritime space between Barbados and Saint Vincent and the Grenadines is a geodetic line defined by the coordinates listed below, expressed with reference to the World Geodetic System 1984 (WGS 84):

2. The coordinates of a point number 1 will be established with a third State along an azimuth of 358° 13’ 22" from Point number 2 in accordance with the same principles used to determine Points number 2 through 14.
3. Point number 14 is on the geodetic line, which has an initial azimuth of 297° 33’ 09" from the coordinates of Point Number 2, as described in the award of 11 April 2006 of the Arbitral Tribunal in the case of Barbados and the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago, which Point is located at 12° 19’.56"N, 60° 16.55’W.
4. For illustrative purposes, the line of delimitation is depicted on the map annexed to this Agreement.

Article 3

The Parties shall, as appropriate, adopt measures and coordinate their activities, in accordance with international law, for the protection and preservation of the marine environment and the conservation and management of the living resources therein.

Article 4

If any single oil or gas structure or field or any other mineral deposit extends across the line of delimitation established in Article 2 and any part of such structure, field or deposit which is situated on one side of the line is exploitable, wholly or in part, from the other side of the line, the Parties shall, after holding the appropriate technical consultations, make every effort to reach agreement on the manner in which any such structure, field or deposit shall be most effectively exploited and on the equitable sharing of the costs and benefits arising from such exploitation.

Article 5

Any dispute between the Parties in relation to the interpretation or the application of this Agreement shall be settled by peaceful means in accordance with international law, including recourse to the dispute settlement provisions of Part XV of the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea.

Article 6

1. The Parties shall inform each other by exchange of diplomatic note of the completion of their domestic law procedures required for the entry into force of this Agreement.
2. The Agreement shall enter into force on the first day of the second month following the date of the last notification.

In witness whereof the undersigned, duly authorized by their respective Governments, have signed this Agreement.
