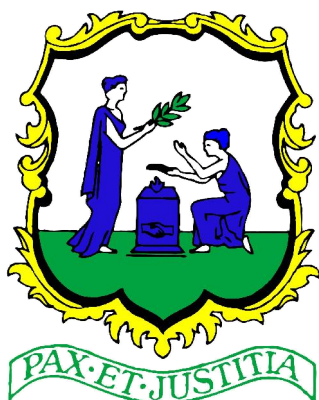

Eligibility/Requirements

To be eligible Candidates must:

- hold or expect to hold a first degree of at least upon second class honours or a second class degree and a relevant post graduate qualification;

- have graduated within the least 10 years;
- PhD candidates should submit supporting statement from U.K. University of First Choice. Failure to do so will result in CSC placing the student at a University of their choice;
- Candidates should select one (1) but no more than three (3) universities of choice.
