JUSTICE OF APPEAL

To be based at the Headquarters of the Eastern Caribbean Supreme Court in Saint Lucia. Applicants will hear appeals in all Member States and Territories of the Eastern Caribbean Supreme Court in accordance with the Schedule of Sittings of the Court of Appeal.

Applicants for the position of Justice of Appeal must:

- (a) be or have been for a period or periods amounting in the aggregate to not less than five (5) years a judge of a court of unlimited jurisdiction in civil and criminal matters in some part of the Commonwealth or a court having jurisdiction in appeals from such a court; or
- (b) be qualified to practise as an advocate in such a court, and has so practised for a period or periods amounting in the aggregate to, not less than fifteen (15) years.

Applicants are also expected to possess a high level of personal integerity and if successful are expected to subscribe to the Code of Ethics of the Judiciary of the Eastern Caribbean Supreme Court.
