#### 1. SUPPLEMENTARY ESTIMATES 2021 OF ST. VINCENT AND THE GRENADINES

**WHEREAS** Section 70 (3) of the Constitution of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines provides for the laying of Supplementary Estimates before the House of Assembly if in respect of any financial year it is found that the amount appropriated by the Appropriation Law to any purpose is insufficient or that a need has arisen for expenditure for a purpose to which no amount has been appropriated by that Law; or that any moneys have been expended for any purpose in excess of the amount appropriated to that purpose by the Appropriation Law or for a purpose to which no amount has been appropriated by that Law;

**AND WHEREAS** Supplementary Estimates 2021 have been prepared and laid in the House of Assembly.

**BE IT RESOLVED** that this Honourable House do approve the Supplementary Estimates 2021.
