Referees should not be related to you and should be able to give an assessment of your professional abilities as well as your character. DECLARATION OF ACQUISITION OF LAND

WHEREAS it is enacted by Section 3 of the Land Acquisition Act, Chapter 322 that if the Governor-General considers that any land should be acquired for a public purpose, she may cause a declaration to that effect to be made:

AND WHEREAS it is considered by the Governor-General, that the under mentioned parcels of land should be acquired for a public purpose, to wit, for the location of the COVID 19 medical isolation facility.

NOW IT IS HEREBY DECLARED by Her Excellency, the Governor-General, acting in accordance with the advice of the Cabinet of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, that upon the Second Publication of this Declaration in the Gazette, all that portion of lands situated at Argyle, in the Parish of St. George in the State of St. Vincent and the Grenadines belonging to Estate of Marcus Thomas measuring in total 2,618 square feet. together with all ways water and watercourses rights, lights, liberties, privileges, paths, easements and all other appurtenances thereon shall vest absolutely in the Crown.

AS IT IS HEREBY FURTHER DECLARED AND NOTIFIED that a drawing bearing registration number G3359 lots no. 1 and 2 outlining the above-mentioned area is at the Land and Surveys Department and can be inspected at all reasonable hours at the said Department.

INVITATION TO BID

The Government of St. Vincent and the Grenadines (GOSVG) has received financing from the Caribbean Development Bank (CDB) in an amount equivalent to USD12.317 million towards the cost of the **Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET) Development Project** and intends to apply a part of the funds to cover eligible payments under the Agreement. Payment by CDB will be made only at the request of GOSVG and upon approval by CDB, and will be subject, in all respects, to the terms and conditions of the Loan Agreement. The Loan Agreement prohibits a withdrawal from the Loan Account for the purpose of any payment to persons or entities, or for any import of goods, if such payment or import, to the knowledge of CDB, is prohibited by a decision of the United Nations Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations. No party other than GOSVG shall derive any rights from the Loan Agreement or have any claim to the proceeds of the Loan.

The Ministry of Education and National Reconciliation, Project Implementation Unit, now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified Bidders for the **Supply of Goods and Services for the Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET) Development Project** in Lots 1, 2, 3 & 4 as follows. The bidder may bid for any individual Lot or any combination of Lots as further defined in the bidding document. Bidders wishing to offer discounts in case they are awarded more than one contract will be allowed to do so, provided those discounts are included in the Letter of Bid.

- (a) Lot 1 Auto Mechanic Equipment
- (b) Lot 2 Auto Cad Equipment
- (c) Lot 3 Crop Production Equipment
- (d) Lot 4 Safety Equipment

Consideration will be limited to firms or joint ventures of firms which are legally incorporated or otherwise organised in, and have their principal place of business in an eligible country and are either:

- (a) more than 50% beneficially-owned by a citizen or citizens and/or *bona fide* resident or residents of an eligible country, or by a body corporate or bodies corporate meeting these requirements; or
- (b) owned or controlled by the Government of an eligible country provided that it is legally and financially autonomous and operated under the commercial law of an eligible country and otherwise meets the eligibility requirements of the CDB Guidelines for Procurement (2006).

Eligible countries are member countries of CDB.

Eligible bidders will be required to submit full qualification information with their bids establishing their eligibility to bid and qualification to perform the contract if the bid is accepted. Tender and qualification information are to be submitted in the English Language on the prescribed forms inserted in the Bid Documents. Submissions that do not provide the information required or that do not demonstrate the prospective contractor's ability to perform satisfactorily, will not qualify and will not be considered for further evaluation.

Bid documents will be available for inspection at the first address below, from Friday, September 24th, 2021 at 8:30 a.m., on weekdays between 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Requests may be made by personal application or in writing via email. The bid document would be emailed upon requests.
