ORGANISATION OF AMERICAN STATES (OAS) SCHOLARSHIP 2022/ 2023

Applications are invited from suitably qualified persons for Scholarships offered by the Organisation of American States (OAS) for **undergraduate** and **postgraduate** studies for the 2022/2023 academic year. Applicants must be citizens or permanent residents of an OAS Member State.

UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIPS are offered as a self-placed scholarship for the last two (2) academic years of study leading to an undergraduate degree. Applicants must be:

- enrolled in the programme of study and be eligible to graduate within two (2) academic years of study from the date of scholarship;
- accepted into the university where he/she plans to study for the last two (2) academic years of undergraduate degree (Bachelor's degree);

 be in good physical and mental health to complete programme.

Applicants already enrolled in a programme must submit current transcript and copies of CXC/GCE O'Level and A'Level Exam Certificates.

Applicants for POSTGRADUATE STUDIES must:

- have obtained a university degree (Bachelor's) at the time of submitting their applications;
- be enrolled in the programme of study and have at least one (1) academic year left from the date of scholarship offer, or
- be accepted into the university where he or she plans to study;
- submit a copy of degree certificate;
- be in good physical and mental health to complete programme.

Applicants who intend to pursue studies outside the Caribbean should sit the GRE or GMAT Exams. Also, note that the scholarship programme does not award scholarships for studies in the Medical Sciences or the learning of a new language. Additionally, scholarships are not awarded to study at universities in the applicant's sponsoring country.

INVITATION TO BID

The Government of St. Vincent and the Grenadines (GOVSVG) has received financing from the Caribbean Development Bank (CDB) in an amount equivalent to USD 12.317 million towards the cost of the Technical and **Vocational Education and Training (TVET)** Development Project and intends to apply a part of the funds to cover eligible payments under the Agreement. Payment by CDB will be made only at the request of GOVSVG and upon approval by CDB, and will be subject; in all respects, to the terms and conditions of the Loan Agreement. The Loan Agreement prohibits a withdrawal from the Loan Account for the purpose of any payment to persons on entities, or for any import of goods, if such payment or import, to the knowledge of CDB, is prohibited by a decision of the United Nations Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations. No party other than GOVSVG shall derive any rights from the Loan Agreement or have any claim to the proceeds of the Loan.

The Ministry of Education and National Reconciliation, Project Implementation Unit, now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified **Bidders for the Supply of Goods and Services for the Technical Vocational and Education** Training (TVET) Development Project in Lot 1 as follows. Bidders wishing to offer discounts in case they are awarded the contract will be allowed to do so, provided those discounts are included in the Letter of Bid.

(a) Lot 1 - Auto Mechanic Equipment

Condiseration will be limited to firms or joint ventures of firms which are legally incorporated or otherwise organised in, and have their principal place of business in an eligible country and are either

- (a) more than 50% beneficially-owned by a citizen or citizens and/or bona fide resident or residents of an eligible country, or by a body corporate or bodies corporate meeting these requirements; or
- (b) owned or controlled by the Government of an eligible country provided that it is legally and financially autonomous and operated under the commercial law of an eligible country and otherwise meets the eligibility requirements of the CDB Guidelines for Procurement (2006).

Eligible countries are member countries of CDB.

Eligible bidders will be required to submit full qualification information with their bids establishing their eligibility to bid and qualification to perform the contract if the bid is accepted. Tender and qualification information are to be submitted in the English Language on the prescribed forms inserted in the Bid Documents. Submissions that do not provide the information required or that do not demonstrate the prospective contractor's ability to perform satisfactorily, will not qualify and will not be considered for further evaluation.

Bid documents will be available for inspection at the first address below, from Monday, February 14th, 2022 at 8:30 a.m., on weekdays between 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Requests may be made by personal application or in writing via email. Written applications must be clearly marked: "Request for Bid Documents for the supply of Goods and Services for TVET Development Project: Phase E - Technical and Vocational Education and Training Development Project". The bid document would be emailed upon request.

Four (4) hard copies of Bids and one (1) electronic copy on a flash drive must be submitted in sealed envelopes, with the name and address of the bidder, and be clearly marked "Tender for Supply of Goods and Services for TVET Development Project: Phase E - Technical and Vocational Education and Training Development Project" and must be delivered to the second address below no later than Wednesday, 30th March, 2022 at 1:15 p.m. Eastern Caribbean Time. Bids will be opened publicly immediately after the deadline for submission of bids, in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the second address below.

Each bid must be accompanied by a "Bid Security" in the appropriate amount, as identified in the tender document, for each lot of. Late bids will be rejected.
