RESOLUTION

COVID-19 (MISCELLANEOUS AMENDMENTS) ORDER 2021, (NO. 32 OF 2021)

MOVED BY DR. THE HONOURABLE RALPH E. GONSALVES

PRIME MINISTER

WHEREAS, section 2 (2) of the COVID-19 (Miscellaneous Amendments) Act 2020, No. 5 of 2020, provides that the Minister may by order amend the Schedule to the Act, to provide for the modification of any existing law and such law shall, unless a contrary intention is indicated, be deemed to be amended from the date of the publication of the order in the Gazette; and

WHEREAS, by section 2 (3) of the Act and Order made by the Minister under section 2 (2) shall cease to have effect if a resolution confirming the Order is not passed in the House of Assembly within two months of the commencement of the Order;

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 (Miscellaneous Amendments) Order 2021, No. 32 of 2021, was made on the 12th day of November, 2021 and published in the Gazette in accordance with Section 2 (2) of the Act; and

WHEREAS, under section 2 (3) of the Act, the period of two months referred to in Section 2 (2) of the Act for the passing of a resolution confirming the Order was extended by the Covid-19 (Miscellaneous Amendments) (Extension) Order 2021, No. 41 of 2021, and further extended by the Covid-19 (Miscellaneous Amendments) (Extension) Order, 2022, No. 9 of 2022:

NOW BE IT RESOLVED, that this Honourable House approve the COVID-19 (Miscellaneous Amendments) Order 2021, No. 32 of 2021.
