RALPH GONSALVES**, Prime Minister, Minister of National Security, Legal Affairs and Information.

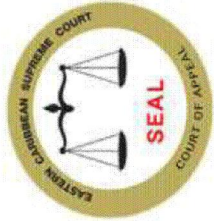
