WHEREAS, Section 4 of the Public Holidays Act, Cap. 274 of the Laws of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, Revised Edition, 2009 provides that the Governor-General acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister may at any time, by proclamation, declare a day which is not normally a public holiday to be a Public Holiday;

NOW THEREFORE, I DAME SUSAN DOUGAN, G.C.M.G., O.B.E., GOVERNOR-GENERAL of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, do hereby PROCLAIM the 28th day of November, 2025 to be a Public Holiday in Saint Vincent and the Grenadines.
