**WHEREAS** by Instrument dated the 2nd day of December, 2025, **HONOURABLE GODWIN FRIDAY** was charged with the due administration of departments and subjects particularly enumerated herein according to the law and usages of the Constitution and subject to any variations which might thereafter be made to the said directions until the said directions as the same might be varied from time to time.

**AND WHEREAS** the said **GODWIN FRIDAY** shall not be administering the departments or subjects with the administration of which he has been charged as aforesaid:

**NOW THEREFORE** by virtue of the power of authority vested in me by the Saint Vincent Constitution Order 1979, and acting in accordance with the advice of the Honourable Prime Minister,

I hereby charge you Honourable St. Claire Leacock, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of National Security, Disaster Management and Immigration with the due administration of the departments or subjects particularly enumerated hereunder according to the law and usages of the Constitution from April 11th, 2026, and until the resumption of duties by the HONOURABLE GODWIN FRIDAY, Prime Minister, Minister of Finance, Legal Affairs and Justice, Economic Planning and Private Sector Development.
