| 2. The Anti-Terrorism Act 2023, in this Act referred to as the principal Act, is to be regarded as coming into force from the 31st day of March 2023. | Commencement

| 3. Anything done under a power conferred by the principal Act, between the 31st day of March 2023 and the date of coming into force of this Act, is deemed to have been done lawfully if done in accordance with the provisions of the principal Act. | Validation |
| 4. The principal Act is amended in section 1 by deleting subsection (2). | Consequential
amendment |
